What is the Community Computer and Employment Resource Center?

The Community Computer and Employment Resource Center is grant funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act. This grant is a partnership with the Plattsburgh Public Library and the North Country Workforce Partnerships. The goal of this center is to expand public computer center hours of service. The center is also there to provide the workforce on using computers and using computers to write resumes and seek employment. The center is staffed by a Director and an Assistant Director.

What Services Are Available at the Community Computer and Employment Resource Center?

Some of the services that are available at the Community Computer and Employment Resource Center include: Computer workshops, resume writing workshops, cover letter and thank you letter workshops, job search workshops and benefits counseling for those on Social Security benefits who would like to enter the workforce.

Who Can Use the Services at the Community Computer and Employment Resource Center?

The services at the Community Computer and Employment Resource Center are open to the public and for those who are searching for employment.
